

# Japan's ODA: Rolling Plan for the Republic of Mali

As of July 1, 2011

[Diplomatic Consideration, etc.]

The Malian Embassy in Tokyo and the Japanese Embassy in Mali were respectively established in June 2002 and January 2008.

The security concern, caused by active terrorist groups in the northern part of Mali, The gouvernement of Mali is struggling to this problem in liaison with neighboring countries, such as Algeria, Mauritania, Niger. Noted the impact of the security situation of assistance to Mali.

Presidential election is planned to take place in 2012.

The improvement of agricultural production and distribution, as well as its sustainable development are necessary for promoting agriculture, forestry and fishing sectors through the reinforcement of cooperative associations, the improvement in product diversity and livelihood and rural infrastructure.
