



For returnees and entrants from the UK, South Africa, Ireland, Israel, Brazil, United Arab Emirates, Italy, Austria, Netherlands, Switzerland, Sweden, Slovakia, Denmark, Germany, Nigeria, France, Belgium, Estonia, Czech, Pakistan, Hungary, Poland, Luxembourg, Lebanon, Ukraine, Philippines

- If you have stayed in the UK, South Africa, Ireland, Israel, Brazil, United Arab Emirates, Italy, Austria, Netherlands, Switzerland, Sweden, Slovakia, Denmark, Germany, Nigeria, France, Belgium, Estonia, Czech, Pakistan, Hungary, Poland, Luxembourg, Lebanon, Ukraine, Philippines within the last 14 days, you must **submit an inspection certificate of pre-entry test issued within 72 hours prior to departure**, in response to the spread of the mutated Covid-19.
 - ① **Submit inspection certificate**
 - At the time of entry, submit or present a certificate or a copy of certificate of pre-entry test issued within 72 hours prior to departure and certified as "negative" by the local medical institution to the quarantine officer.
 - ② **Quarantine in the accommodation of the government**
 - You will be tested for Covid-19 at the airport and will be quarantined in the accommodation of the government.
 - If you do not follow the instructions of the quarantine officer, you may be detained in accordance with the Quarantine Act.
 - On the third day after your entry to the accommodation, you will be tested again. If the result is negative, you will leave the accommodation.
 - After leaving the accommodation, you must remain at home , etc. for 14 days after entering Japan.
 - ③ **Submit written pledge**
 - You will need to submit a written pledge to remain at home, etc. for 14 days after arrival, not to use public transportation, to report your health conditions using the LINE application, etc., to store your location information using a map application function, and to use Covid-19 Contact-Confirming Application.
 - If you violate the pledge, your name (name and nationality if you are non-Japanese) and information that contributes to the prevention of the spread of infection may be publicized.
 - In addition to the above if you are a non- Japanese, you may be subject to revocation of status of residence and deportation etc. under the provisions of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act in case of the violation.



For returnees and entrants from overseas
(except the UK, South Africa, Ireland, Israel, Brazil, United Arab Emirates, Italy, Austria, Netherlands, Switzerland, Sweden, Slovakia, Denmark, Germany, Nigeria, France, Belgium, Estonia, Czech, Pakistan, Hungary, Poland, Luxembourg, Lebanon, Ukraine, Philippines)

• **You must submit an inspection certificate of pre-entry test issued within 72 hours prior to departure.**

① **Submit inspection certificate**

- At the time of entry, submit or present a certificate or a copy of certificate of pre-entry test issued within 72 hours prior to departure and certified as "negative" by the local medical institution to the quarantine officer.

② **Test at the airport**

- You will be tested for Covid-19 at the airport .If the result is negative, you have to remain at home, etc. and do not have to use public transportation for 14 days after entering Japan.

③ **Submit written pledge**

- You will need to submit a written pledge to remain at home, etc. for 14 days after arrival, not to use public transportation, to report your health conditions using the LINE application, etc., to store your location information using a map application function, and to use Covid-19 Contact-Confirming Application.
- If you violate the pledge, your name (name and nationality if your are non-Japanese) and information that contributes to the prevention of the spread of infection may be publicized.
- In addition to the above if you are a non- Japanese, you may be subject to revocation of status of residence and deportation etc. under the provisions of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act in case of the violation.

④ **Target group**

- All persons returning to or entering Japan from abroad (except the UK, South Africa, Ireland, Israel, Brazil, United Arab Emirates, Italy, Austria, Netherlands, Switzerland, Sweden, Slovakia, Denmark, Germany, Nigeria, France, Belgium, Estonia, Czech, Pakistan, Hungary, Poland, Luxembourg, Lebanon, Ukraine, Philippines) are subject to the above measures.



To Everyone Entering Japan

(Installing apps required for preventing the spread of COVID-19)

The airport quarantine will check your smartphone when you arrive in Japan.

If you do not own a smartphone or if you own a smartphone that does not allow the installation of apps, please rent a smartphone at the airport at your expense upon arriving in Japan.

Please install the following apps on your smartphone and use them to ensure implementation of stay at home or the accommodation, etc. for 14 days after arriving in Japan.

* When you arrive in Japan, you will be asked to submit a written pledge regarding stay at home or the accommodation and use of location information-confirming apps, etc. for the 14-day period after landing in Japan. If you breach the pledge, your name and other information may be publicized. Foreign nationals may be subject to procedures for revocation of residence status and deportation under the Immigration Control Act.

(1) Install Overseas Entrants Locator (OEL) (Location information-confirming app)	Required for reporting your location information.
(2) Install and sign up for Skype or WhatsApp (Video call app)	Required for answering video calls from persons in charge to confirm your location.
(3) Set your smartphone to save location information (Settings on GoogleMaps, etc.)	Required for presenting a record of your location information to the health center or other facilities in case you tested positive after arriving in Japan.
(4) Install COVID-19 Contact-Confirming Application (COCOA) (Contact-confirming app)	Receive notifications about the possibility of contact with COVID-19 infected persons.
